

Savage Stock Media Privacy Policy

Privacy is important and This Savage Stock Media Privacy Policy explains how Savage Stock Media LLC, which is an Oregon limited liability company (“Savage Stock Media, LLC”) collects and uses the personal information you provide to us on our website www.savagestock.net and through email and any other direct correspondence. It also describes the choices available to you regarding our use of your personal information and how you can access and update this information.

By using this site, you agree to the usage, disclosure and data collection that is explained in this privacy policy.

We will only process your personal information in accordance with applicable data protection and privacy laws. For the purpose of UK and European Union data protection legislation, the data controller is Savage Stock Media, LLC, which is located in Albany, Oregon.

COLLECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

We collect information about you in a variety of forms, which includes personal information. the following personal information is what we collect from you:

- Information You Provide to us might include personal information, such as your name, phone number, mobile number, location, payment information, employment information, video/music samples, user name and email address when you communicate with us, register for our Service, sign up for our mailing list, or communicate with us. The information we may receive from third-party sites is dependent upon that third party’s policies and your privacy settings on that third-party site. You should always review and, if necessary, adjust your privacy settings on third-party websites and services before linking or connecting them to our website or Service. We may obtain information from other sources, such as third-party information providers, or through mergers and acquisitions, and combine this with information previously collected. In these cases, our Privacy Policy governs the handling of the combined personal information.

-Information Automatically Collected: As is true of most websites, we automatically gather information about your computer such as your IP address, browser type, referring/exit pages and operating system.

USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

We use your personal information to Provide and update information about your order and account which includes fulfilling and processing payment, responding to customer service requests, questions and concerns, sending order confirmations, licensing info and service and product information. It is also used to help improve our website and marketing. We also Comply with applicable laws, lawful requests and legal process, including to respond to requests from public and government authorities and Enforce this privacy policy, and protect our rights, privacy, safety or property, and/or that of you or others.

INFORMATION SHARING

We do not sell your personal information to third parties, and will only share your personal information with third parties in the ways that are described in this Policy. We may provide your personal information to companies that provide services to help us with our business activities such as offering customer service. These companies are authorized to use your personal information only as necessary to provide these services to us. We may also disclose your personal information as required by law such as to comply with a subpoena, or similar legal process, including to respond to requests from public and government authorities to meet national security or law enforcement requirement; when we believe in good faith that disclosure is necessary to protect our rights, protect your safety or the safety of others, investigate fraud, or respond to a government request.

COOKIES AND OTHER TRACKING TECHNOLOGIES

We may use cookies and other electronic tracking technologies to keep track of your visits, preferences and profile information. A cookie is a small, unique text file that a website can send to your computer when you visit a site. We may use session cookies, which terminate when a user closes his or her browser, and/or persistent cookies, which remain on the user's computer until manually deleted. Most web browsers can either alert you to the use of cookies or refuse to accept cookies entirely. If you do not want us to deploy cookies to your browser, you can set your browser to reject cookies or to notify you when a website tries to put a cookie on your computer. Rejecting cookies may affect your ability to use the Site. Electronic tracking technologies are used to enhance your experience on the Site, including allowing you to remain logged in on the Site. Cookies and pixel tags may also be used to collect general usage and aggregated statistical information that does not identify you personally. However, we may use cookies to store some of your preferences (including limited personal information) or to display relevant content based upon what you view on our Site. In addition, we may use action tags in emails. This allows us to gauge the effectiveness of certain communications and the effectiveness of marketing campaigns by showing, for example, how many emails have been opened. Unlike cookies, which are stored on the hard drive of your computer or mobile device by a website, tags are embedded invisibly on web pages. The information we collect using tags is not linked to our users' personal information.

INTERNATIONAL DATA TRANSFER

The personal information that we collect from you may be transferred to, stored and processed by us outside the country in which you reside, including, but not limited to, the United States, where data protection and privacy regulations may not offer the same level of protection as in other parts of the world. By using this Site, you consent to such transfer, storage and processing. We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this privacy statement.

Our Site may contain links to third party websites and features. This privacy statement does not cover the privacy practices of such third parties. These third parties have their own privacy policies and we do not accept any responsibility or liability for their websites, features or policies. Please read their privacy policies before you submit any data to them.

SECURITY

We make every effort to help ensure the integrity and security of our network and systems, but we cannot guarantee our security measures. When you enter sensitive information (such

as your credit card number) on our order forms, we encrypt the transmission of that information using secure socket layer technology (SSL). When you create an account, you are prompted to create a password with that account. You are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of your password, and you are responsible for any access to or use of your account by someone else that has obtained your password, whether or not such access or use has been authorized by you. You should notify us of any unauthorized use of your password or account. We follow generally accepted industry standards to protect the personal information submitted to us, both during transmission and once we receive it.
